MHTN – Scott Later from MHTN gave us an update on the plans for the new building. The current building will stay functional throughout the new construction. The district has purchased .75 acres just south of the current parking lot. There will be approx. 125 parking stalls. Parent Drop Off will be from 800 West (Onion Street). It will be a one-way loop that will have a left turn and right turn lane to exit. The Bus drop off will come in from 400 North and be around the faculty lot. The current plans show 2 playgrounds (1 for K-2 and 1 for 3-6). There is also a Zen Garden and Outdoor Classroom space. The bowery and catwalk will stay where they are. The track and fence around the school will be replaced.

The first floor will have the administrative offices, dining room and kitchen, multi-purpose room/ stage, and 16 classrooms. The second floor has the media center, imaginarium, and 8 classrooms.

The timeline: Bids must be in soon. Construction should start in mid-November and finish in February/ March of 2020. The Big Toy will be moved for continued student access during construction. That Spring we will transition into the new school and the old building will be demolished. We should be completed and ready for Fall of 2020.

Construction vehicles will access the site from 400 North. A portion of the existing parking lot will be closed off for this. Drop off will not be impacted.

Plans will go to the School Board to be approved this month. Once approved, they will be posted on school website. We will also post information about the ground breaking ceremony.
