- Reading Goal: 66% of students in grades 1-3 will show typical or higher progress on the End of Level (EOY) Acadience Reading Pathways to Progress.
- 2. Math Goal: 85% of students in grades K-6 will demonstrate proficiency at 80% of higher on a grade level common assessment in Mathematics.
- 3. Science & Technology: Implement STEM teaching and learning processes into every classroom to create a comprehensive STEM learning environment for students. 82% of students in grades 4-6 will demonstrate proficiency at 80% or higher on a grade level common assessment in science.
